### About the Community Fellowships

- Aim to meet the research needs of community organisations to conduct small research projects
- Projects could involve conducting a scoping report, literature review, data analysis, a small research project leading to positive outcomes, improved capacity to undertake future research and more

### Benefits

- Up to \$5000 to the community organisation to compensate for the time the Fellow spends working at the University of Melbourne
- Outcomes of the research project, and research capacity building for the Fellow and community organisation
- Academic mentoring and research skills training for the Fellow
- Library access, hot-desking space (subject to COVID-19 restrictions), internet facilities and a University email address

### Eligibility

Up to two Indigenous Community Fellows will be appointed who:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Are working at an Indigenous community organisation or focusing on an Indigenous topic in their Fellowship proposal
- Meet the general criteria for the Community Fellows application

No prior research experience is required. The program is not suitable for applicants with a PhD or significant research experience.
